

2012 London Parent / Chaperone Guidelines

Attractions

1. Timelines are critical! Please be prompt. We have a tight schedule to keep. Each group will have a designated leader to ensure that at each attraction we remain together and on time. Please listen carefully to your leader's instructions.
2. Be aware! Group leaders will check for every student and parent in your group when you leave a site. Your leader will be responsible for counting your group at arrival and departure at every stop. Both students and parents should pay careful attention to those in their group.
3. Know your schedule! Make sure that your group is where it needs to be when it needs to be. Please do not hold up the group!
4. Judge your time carefully! On the few occasions when groups divide for lunch or dinner, be sure not to choose a restaurant with a long waiting list.
5. Please understand the importance of being a chaperone! It is very easy to forget that you are a chaperone and become the tourist. Most importantly, be aware of your group and be on time!
6. Pay attention! When traveling the Tube, you need to pay careful attention to your group leader at all times! Stay close by them and be ready to step on and off when instructed to.

6. Be considerate! Avoid running and loud talking in your room or in the hallways. Please do not slam doors! It disturbs other hotel guests.
