

2012 LONDON PACKING LIST

Each student is to have **one** suitcase and **one** backpack.

Please weigh the suitcase to make sure that it does not weigh more than 50 pounds. (An extra fee will be charged by the airline if it goes over) Remember that you may want to bring souvenirs back home, so leave some room.

- ❑ Bible, clipboard, pen/pencil
- ❑ Backpack
- ❑ Jacket (wind and water repellent) OR jacket with poncho/raincoat
- ❑ 3-5 Sweaters/sweatshirts (at least 1 hoodie)
- ❑ 7 long sleeve T-shirts
- ❑ 7 Undergarments
- ❑ 7 Pairs of socks
- ❑ 2 long johns or legging
- ❑ 2-3 Jeans/pants
- ❑ 2 pairs Tennis shoes/comfortable shoes
- ❑ **Watch** that has an alarm and that you know how to set!!
- ❑ Sleeping attire/pajamas
- ❑ Spending money (Small bills if possible) / secure wallet
- ❑ Toiletry items (toothbrush, deodorant, shampoo, brush/comb, etc.)
- ❑ If packing a hairdryer, don't forget the converter
- ❑ Washcloth
- ❑ Warm hat, gloves, scarf, sunglasses
- ❑ Camera/film/batteries/charger
- ❑ Medication (if needed) in Ziploc bag labeled
- ❑ Snacks for the road (optional)
- ❑ Cell phone (optional - only to be used at hotel for a quick call home – students may not use them to listen to music or play games - be aware that international calls are very expensive)

Note: The weather in London can be very variable. When packing and dressing think in terms of layering your clothes. Please do not bring a bulky ski jacket.

THINGS NOT TO BRING

IPods, mp3 players, hand-held games

Any other electronic gadgets

Pillows, blankets, sleeping bags, stuffed animals
